Maharaja Ranjit Singh AFPI, Mohali has been the premier training Institution & Centre of Excellence of the Government of Punjab in training youth of Punjab for commission into the Indian Armed Forces through the National Defence Academy or equivalent training Academies. It is aiming to train and enhance the numbers of Punjab domicile youth as officers in the Armed Forces. AFPI is well on its way to becoming the premier feeder Institution of officers for the Armed Forces of India.

OUR MISSION

We at Maharaja Ranjit Singh AFPI, Mohali are dedicated to provide the highest standards of focussed training in the professional, academic, physical & leadership spheres. We endeavour to provide moral & ethical grooming to cadets using innovative concepts, technologies and modern practice with a view to groom them to become competent potential leaders with a high standard of integrity & discipline. We thus equip our cadets to become good citizens of this country in general and excellent junior leaders in the Armed Forces of India in particular. PROGRAMS

Duration of Training : Two years at the Plus 1 & Plus 2 levels.

Capacity : 48 cadets per year. Total 96 cadets

TRAINING IMPARTED

Academic: (Plus 1 & 2) in a good school in Mohali.

All cadets study in the Non-Medical Science Stream with Computer Science/Physical Education.

Physical Fitness : Physical Training, Sports, Swimming, Firing and Drill.

Personality Development, Communication Skills & Soft Skills. Preparation for the NDA Entrance Examination and Services Selection Board (SSB) Interview.

ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Domicile of Punjab only.
- Studying in Class 10th.
- Desirous of joining NDA.
- Date of Birth- **Born NOT earlier than 02 Jan 2010.**

ENTRANCE PROCEDURE

- **Written Test on 03 Jan 2027.** Total No of questions 150.
- Subjects - English (40/150), Mathematics (70/150), Science & Social Studies (40/150). Level- CBSE X standard.
- Test: Objective type, answers on OMR Sheet.
- Selected candidates called for interview and test of communication skills in Jan/Feb/Mar 2027 depending on the 10th Board Exams.
- Successful Candidates will be medically examined.
- First 48 candidates as per order of merit will be invited to join the Institute in April 2027.

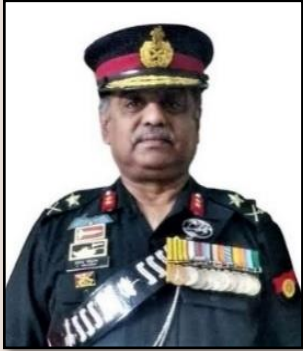
FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- **Boarding, Lodging, Messing , Uniform & Training as per Punjab Govt directions. All training at AFPI imparted free of cost.**
- Cadets only pay school fees for the school (Approx Rs. 66,000/- per year, payable in three installments).

Note:

- School Fees may increase marginally as decided by the school.
- Exact amount will be intimated later.
- Candidates who have already passed Class 10 and are currently studying in Class 11 may also apply provided they meet the age criteria. However, such candidates, if selected for admission will be required to repeat Class 11.
